At a glance — a one-page overview of the safety principles behind every Core Nail Wellness visit. The underlying procedures remain controlled.

Core Nail Wellness provides appointment-based, on-site nail wellness services within senior living and care communities. Every visit, in every community, follows the same documented safety framework.

Every Visit Follows These Ten Commitments

01 Resident Dignity & Consent — Residents are informed and may accept, decline, pause, or stop at any time. Consent is ongoing.

02 Pre-Service Screening — The service area is observed before every service, every visit. Screening is not a diagnosis.

03 Scope of Service — Licensed nail wellness only. No diagnosis, treatment, podiatry, nursing, or wound care.

04 Referral & Facility Notification — Objective visible observations are documented and reported to the designated facility contact when authorized or required.

05 Infection-Prevention Practices — Hand hygiene, cleaned and disinfected implements, single-use items where required, and clean attire.

06 Blood Exposure Response — A defined response, with basic first aid only, within the technician's lawful scope.

07 Service Modification, Refusal & Early Exit — Service may be modified, deferred, stopped, or declined whenever resident safety requires.

08 Privacy & Documentation — Every visit is documented; resident information is handled on a need-to-know basis.

09 Facility Partnership Responsibilities — Safe service is shared: a named contact, suitable space, consent readiness, and access.

10 Clean Product Selection — Products are selected against CNW's documented Clean Product Standards, not marketing claims.

What You Can Expect

CNW Provides

- Licensed on-site nail wellness for hands and feet
- Manicures, pedicures, and dry-technique pedicures
- A clean, portable workstation — bedside or at a wellness station
- A written service record for every visit
- Observations referred to the designated facility contact
- Family updates when authorized

CNW Does Not Provide

- Medical diagnosis or treatment
- Podiatry, nursing, or wound care
- Diabetic foot care or medical risk clearance
- Removal of living tissue, or razor-type callus shavers
- Services outside North Carolina manicurist licensure
- Service without consent, or mobile and vehicle-based service

Core Nail Wellness is a licensed North Carolina nail wellness practice serving clients in healthcare and community settings, operating in compliance with North Carolina state law (21 NCAC 14H). Our founder holds a North Carolina manicurist license (M-82365, issued January 2019) and maintains continuing education in nail health for aging and medically complex populations.

We maintain complete client service records and operate under a comprehensive, controlled document library that governs every aspect of our practice — from infection control to client screening to quality assurance. Proof of insurance is provided during facility credentialing.

Safety without compromise means CNW will not complete a service merely because it was scheduled or paid for. When the safest decision is to pause, modify, defer, or refer, that is the standard of care CNW provides.
